

Russell Perks Martial Arts Academy (RPMAA) Parent/Carer Behaviour Policy

As parents you are expected to:

- Positively reinforce your child and show an interest in their chosen activity.
- Do not place your child under pressure or push them into activities they do not want to do.
- Deliver and collect your child punctually before and after sessions/competitions/Events etc
- Ensure your child has clothing and kit appropriate to the weather conditions.
- Ensure that the correct martial arts are worn for classes. Any child not in possession of the fundamental requirements will not be permitted to participate.
- Detail any relevant medical concerns or conditions pertaining to their child on the registration/consent form. Any changes in the state of the child's health should be reported to **Russell Perks Martial Arts Academy** prior to the activity.
- To inform the organiser prior to the activity starting if there are any changes to the child's drop off/collection time to a lesson or event
- Encourage your child to play by the rules and teach them that they can only do their best.
- Ensure that your child understands their code of conduct.
- Behave responsibly and supportive in all scenarios such as classes, workshops, gradings & other events.
- Ensure your child is punctual.
- Ensure your child has adequate food and drink.
- Accept Russell Perks Martial Arts Academy guidance.

On registering with Russell Perks Martial Arts Academy, we will do the following:

- Assure that your child is safeguarded during their participation in martial arts.
- Inform you of any problems or concerns relating to your children.
- Inform you if your child is injured.
- Have your consent sought for issue such as photography & videos.
- Have any concerns about any aspect of your child's welfare listened to responded to.

Any breaches of this code of conduct will be dealt with immediately by Russell Perks – **Russell Perks Martial Arts Academy** Owner. Persistent concerns or breaches may result in you being asked not to attend classes, workshops, gradings & other events if your attendance is considered detrimental to the welfare of the participants. The ultimate action should a parent/guardian continue to breach the code of behaviour may regrettably result in **Russell Perks Martial Arts Academy** asking your child to leave the classes, workshops, gradings and other events or academy.
